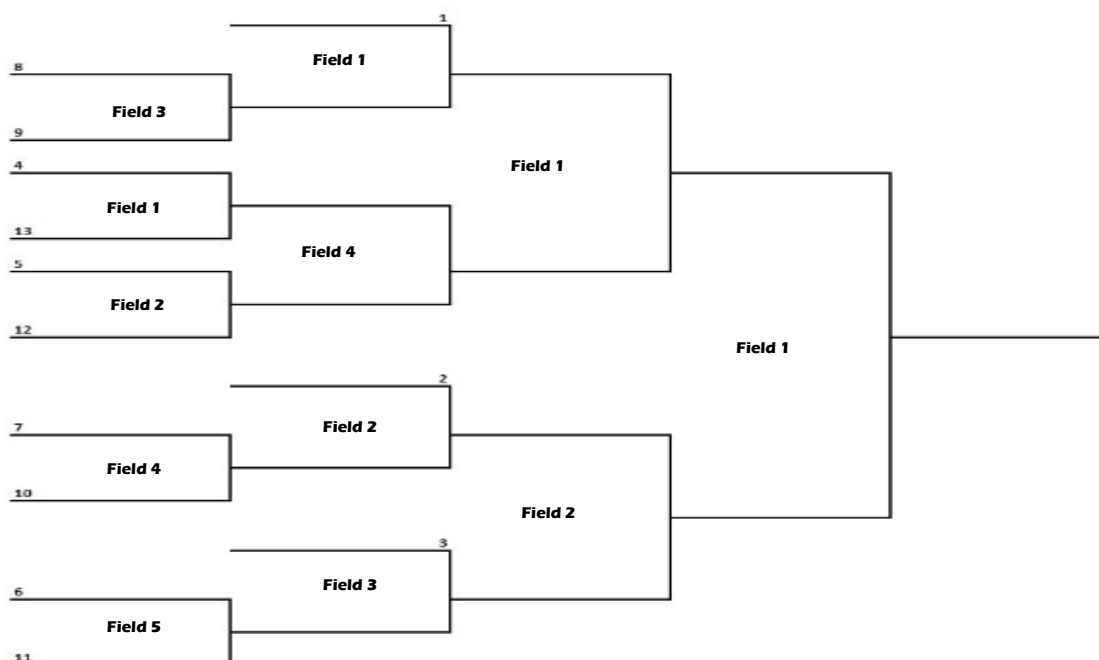

7 on 7 Anti-Bullying Competition Rules

Please read the rules and note that the rules specify that you get out of the huddle in 30 seconds when the ball is set for play. Also, we expect that your defense will, in good faith, use a variety of defensive coverages.

1. Coin flip to determine possession – take it or defer. Play is on a 40-yard field, the ball is placed at the 40-yard line to start the game.
2. Players will be blown dead with a single hand touch below the neck.
3. After score or change of possession, the ball goes back to the 40-yard line.
4. First down marker at 20-yard line – 4 downs to get there for the 1st down.
5. No blocking allowed. Play blown dead at the spot of the ball.
6. Fumbles are dead on the spot.
7. 4 seconds counted by the timer to throw the ball. Failure to get rid of the ball before time expires results in a loss of down.
8. 30 seconds between plays to put ball into play. This will be strictly enforced. Failure to get in and out of the huddle will result in a loss of down.
9. Each team must center the ball. The center is ineligible.
One called time out per game allowed by each team.
10. Pass Interference is a spot foul – automatic first down. In the End Zone, the ball is spotted at the 1-yard line.
11. Scoring System:
 - 6pts – Touchdown (Offensive).
 - 3pts – Interception
** Play is immediately dead after an interception. The Interception cannot be advanced. There is a change of possession on an interception.
 - Extra point (Pass only): 1pt from the 5-yard line, 2 pts from the 10-yard line
12. Two offensive coaches are allowed behind field of play.
Two defensive coaches are allowed in the endzone or out of the field of play

13. Overtime (Tourney Play Only)- Overtime will consist of a coin toss. Winner of the coin toss will determine if they want to play offense or defense. Overtime will consist of 1 play from the 15-yard line. If the Offense scores they are the declared winner. If the defense gets a stop, they are the declared winner.

Bullying can result in reluctance to attend school and truancy, physical complications such as headaches, stomach pains and decreased appetite, it can also cause shame, anxiety, irritability, aggression and depression are also frequent effects all of which can have a significant impact on our children's ability to receive a proper education.

The Cave Wrestling Gym will also provide service to adults in our anti-bullying foundation. Surprisingly, adult bullying has a shocking reality that is unsuspected by the majority of the population. Bullying is still seen as a problem for children in schools and most people never suspect the range, severity and depth of misery created nearly every day, nearly everywhere, by the bullying of adults, by adults. Adult bullies create polluted environments where self-esteem withers, confidence is lost and talents are stifled.

By establishing this foundation our campaign will join the fight to help stop bullying by teaching our children how to identify, handle or report bullying, as well as how to cope with bullying. We will provide skilled mentors at our facility that will help our children boost self-esteem and confidence amongst many other important life skills. We will also teach adults preventative strategies, recognizing adult bullies, as well as coping methods and ways to avoid becoming a victim of bullying.
